ACTION ITEMS

1. **The instrument must be examined 4x a year (seasonally)** by Sarah E Gray Restoration, LLC Now rebranded to The Flatiron Luthier, LLC at the Flatiron Luthier Cooperative at no cost to the recipient. These appointments must be scheduled in advance. If the location poses an undue financial burden on the recipient other arrangements may be made provided the Carruthers cello is examined 4 times a year.
2. **Any maintenance must be performed by an FLC approved shop** prior to any work being done.
3. **Award Recipient is responsible for maintaining** the instrument's bridge position and straightness, keeping a template for post adjustment in the case at all times, proper humidity, and keeping the varnish and wood free from remnant rosin after each use. Special cleaner will be provided for occasional use on non-rosin build-up. Also for any replacement strings needed throughout the year. Recipient will earn the chance to receive a tailored adjustment at no charge within the first month of receiving the instrument.
4. **Should any incident occur it must be documented** on the online incident form provided in the email with this contract and on the SEAK Foundation, inc Website and Sarah Kluge bw contacted immediately **at 402.889.3515**

5. **The instrument** must be kept and used in its original state including the specific type of strings and original fittings provided by the FLC collection.
6. **International travel with the instrument** is not permitted at this time.
